

Run planners see turnout of 100,000

More than 100,000 people in Ontario are expected to walk, run, jog, or swim in Sunday's second annual Terry Fox run.

One of the largest of the 20 runs in Metro Toronto will be at E. T. Seton Park, where between 5,000 and 7,000 are expected. Dick Traum, the New York amputee whose performance in the New York Marathon inspired Terry Fox to tackle a cross-Canada run to raise money for cancer research, will open that run with Isadore Sharp, chairman and president of Four Seasons Hotels.
