

More than a dozen amputees returning from Iraq and Afghanistan will participate for the first time in the West Palm Beach Marathon.


"The team was started three years ago at the Walter Reed Army Medical Center in Washington, DC, when these young men and women were coming back with missing limbs," said Achilles Freedom Team Director Mary Bryant. "It's exactly what our program is about — running, walking, wheelchairing, giving them a goal to work toward so that even after something traumatic happens, they can enhance their rehabilitation. We motivate, train and provide the opportunity to out and get into an endurance sport."
