Central Park Jogger Leads the Way



The Third Annual Hope and Possibility Five Miler recently took place in Central Park with more than 2,000 participants, including more than 75 recently wounded war heroes and hundreds of Achilles kids. There were visually impaired runners, amputees on foot and in wheelchairs, and a power division to accommodate the more severely disabled. Along with able-bodied runners, everyone covered the five-mile course with Trisha Meili, known as the Central Park jogger.

Their next stop will be the Marine Corp Marathon on Oct. 30 in Washington D.C. and the New York City Marathon on Nov. 6.
